ADOLESCENT LITERACY

Help students activate their cognitive processes while reading such as summarizing and rereading using the "Reading Process System". Teaching students that reading is not just decoding—that it is meaning-making or thinking using at least 15 thinking processes—can help them to understand that we are never done learning to read. One way of doing this is using an activity called the 'Metacognitive Funnel'. It is where students "watch" where their attention goes while they read.
