

School District #72 - English Language Learning - Required Documentation

School Registration Process:

During the school year, you can register your child(ren) at your neighbourhood school office during regular school hours. New registrations will be accepted again when the school offices re-open the week immediately prior to the first day of school. *Documentation Requirements:* You must bring your child's birth certificate, Care Card, and a Proof of Residency when registering. Registration forms are available from each school's website or office.

The parent or <u>legal guardian</u> must accompany the student when registering and must present the following original documents of all documents:

1. Proof of Residence in the City of Campbell River:

- For Homeowners: please have a recent property tax statement <u>or</u> a purchased agreement (with subject removal and a deposit receipt) if you just bought a new home, <u>and</u> a recent bill.
- For Tenant(s): please provide current long-term rental <u>or</u> lease agreement, <u>and</u> a recent bill. Please print and complete the <u>Tenancy Agreement Form</u> if your landlord does not provide one.
- 2. **Child's Original Birth Certificate** in English <u>or</u> English translated version. Also, showing parents' names for biological connection to child.
- 3. **Proof of Status in Canada** (*Please bring the original for both parents and child(ren)*)
 - Confirmation of Permanent Residence Document (Landing Paper) and Passport(s) and Permanent Residence Card(s) if available
 - Work Permit and Passport(s)--with parent(s)' minimum of one-year employment letter
 - Study Permit and Passport(s)--with parent(s)' enrolling in a full-time degree or diploma program-please bring admission letter and payment receipt.
 - Refugee Claimant Document
 - Diplomatic Card or Passport(s)
 - Canadian Passport or Citizenship Card or Certificate
 - Any other relevant immigration document.
- 4. **Immunization Records** (if available, <u>no need to translate</u>) and other important health information (e.g. medical alerts).
- 5. Child's Previous School Report Cards in English.
 - Elementary Most recent year of report card
 - Secondary All report cards from Grade 7 (age 13 to present)
 - Any Individual Education Plan (IEP), Psycho-Education Reports, or Medical Reports
