

CAMPBELL RIVER School District 72 Online Platforms: Acceptable Use Guidelines and FIPPA Consent

Parents and, if applicable, secondary school students: Please read the notice below and complete and sign the form on the back of this page and return it to your child's (your) teacher.

School District 72 (Campbell River) is committed to providing our students and teachers with access to learning resources and tools that will help develop the skills students will need in our increasingly digital world. As teachers work to integrate technology rich learning opportunities in the classroom, School District 72 provides student access to various online platforms. Through the use of these online platforms, students are able to engage in collaborative and personalized learning, as well as access online file storage to be used for educational purposes.

Freedom of Information & Protection of Privacy (FIPPA)

As a public body, School District 72 must protect personal information in our custody and ensure that personal information under our control is stored and accessed only in Canada in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA).

In instances where personally identifiable information is required to be able to use an online application, student access will only be provided with parent/guardian consent.

The educational use of an online application may involve the storage and access of these types of personal information:

- Student name;
- Email address:
- School-based projects, assignments, research notes;
- Multimedia objects created by students (e.g. videos, pictures, audio files, art, etc.);
- Communication with teachers, other students, and members of the public related to educational purposes.

If stored outside of Canada, information in your/your child's account may be subject to the laws of foreign jurisdictions. Privacy legislation requires that we inform you of this and obtain your consent.

Acceptable Use Guidelines

The use of online applications by School District 72 staff and students is bound by operational procedure 140 (District Technology and Acceptable Use), operational procedure 301 (Social Media – Students) and operational procedure 143 (Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy). As an overview, students are required to conduct themselves in a courteous, safe, ethical, and responsible manner while using all district technology resources, including online applications.

Steps should be taken by all users to minimize the amount of confidential and/or personally identifiable information shared in any emails, attachments, files, and documents created or uploaded. For example, users should avoid confidential information including home addresses, phone numbers, birthdates, student records/marks, and health information.

Harassment and/or bullying behaviour on online platforms is not acceptable. Inappropriate or prohibited use may lead to suspension or termination of user privileges, legal prosecution or disciplinary action appropriate under any applicable laws, policies, regulations, and collective agreements or contracts.

What Happens if a Parent/Student Does Not Provide Consent?

School District 72 is confident that staff and students will take appropriate measures to safeguard privacy and our staff assessment of a platform's educational value. However, teachers will accommodate non-consenting families with alternative learning options.

Consents are effective immediately and valid until which point the student is no longer a student within the school district, the account has been terminated or permission has been withdrawn.

To ensure the online safety and privacy of SD72 students, the online application(s) listed below have been vetted and approved to guarantee that they meet required guidelines for use in the educational environment.

Elementary and middle school students require parental consent. Secondary students can personally consent. For each application listed below please indicate ONE of the following by initialing under the correct heading:

This consent may be withdrawn at any time in writing but withdrawal of consent does not require the school or district to take any steps to withdraw any previously published material. Unless withdrawn, this consent is effective immediately and lasts until which point the student is no longer a student within the school district or permission has been withdrawn.
