### Guess What Is In The Egg!

PURPOSE / SKILL: Writing and Oral Language

MATERIALS: Plastic Easter Egg OR another container (gift bag, box, etc), handout

OR paper, pencil, colors

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

**STEP ONE:** Choose an object to fit into the egg (or other container) OR choose an image or word to represent an object OR just use the egg drawing on the page.

**STEP TWO:** On the handout (or other paper), write clues that will help someone guess what is in the egg.

**STEP THREE:** Write the answer on the bottom and draw the object in the egg outline..

STEP FOUR: SHARE!! Read your clues to someone. Could they guess?

**STEP FIVE:** Change your clues to make it easier or harder as needed.

**STEP SIX:** Share with a new person. It could be someone in person, over the phone, or through video conference.

**NEXT STEPS:** REPEAT with a new object. Have someone else create the clues. Could you guess it? What makes a clue a GREAT clue?
